NATURAL FORMS

Leaf or Shell Study – Choose a natural object and draw it larger than life, filling the page. \$£€0.-

Cross-Section – Cut a piece of fruit or veg in half and draw the inside shapes and textures. \$£€0.-

Draw a used toothpaste tube, capturing its folds and creases. \$£€0.-

Envelope Art – Draw on an old envelope, using the window, stamps, or folds as part of the design. \$£€0.-
